Situated on the east coast of the Gulf of Thailand about 150km south-east of Bangkok, or just over an hour's drive from Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi International Airport, Pattaya is a lively beach town that draws visitors from around the world. With activities that include a wide range of water sports, golf, shopping, entertainment, zip-lining, Muay Thai and attractions such as waterparks, floating markets, zoos, cultural attractions and plenty of restaurants and bars, Pattaya definitely has something for everyone.

ATTRACTIONS

BEACHES AND ISLANDS

The 6km long Jomtien Beach is popular for windsurfers, kitesurfers and water sports enthusiasts. Hotels and other accommodation is available along the road that runs parallel to the shore.

The crescent-shaped Pattaya Beach is 4km long with Beach Road running along its full length. From the midpoint to the southern end, are plenty of restaurants, bars, department stores, souvenir stores and other sources of entertainment. The quieter atmosphere of the northern section is home to a variety of hotels and mini-resorts.

The quiet Ko Lan Island, 7.5km or 15 minutes by speedboat from Pattaya offers visitors a number of water and beach activities including scuba diving, snorkelling, kayaking and sun bathing. Ko Lan is easily visited as a day trip from Pattaya.

Ko Phai, a small island under the supervision of the Royal Thai Navy, about 14km from Pattaya, has a beautiful white sandy beach and the best scuba diving in the area.



UNDERWATER WORLD PATTAYA

Believed to be the largest and most modern ocean aquarium in Asia, Underwater World Pattaya boasts a 100m long Perspex tunnel through an underwater environment filled with a rich variety of marine life. The aquarium houses more than 4,000 marine animals, with over 200 different species from the region as well as rare creatures from overseas. Top of the must-see list is the rare shovelnose ray, a hybrid between a shark and a stingray. www.underwaterworldpattaya.com beautiful Buddhist temple hosting a weekly market.

KHAO KHEOW OPEN ZOO

Khao Kheow Open Zoo features more than 200 species of wildlife living in their natural habitats. The Zoo is situated in the foothills of the only remaining forest left in the area. The environment is a mixture of dry and evergreen forests that are preserved in their original, natural state. Most of the animals live in large exhibits with appropriately designed environments, and visitors also experience the animals up close. There is also a Night Safari Tour by train: 5.30 to 8.30pm daily.

SHOPPING AND DINING
